

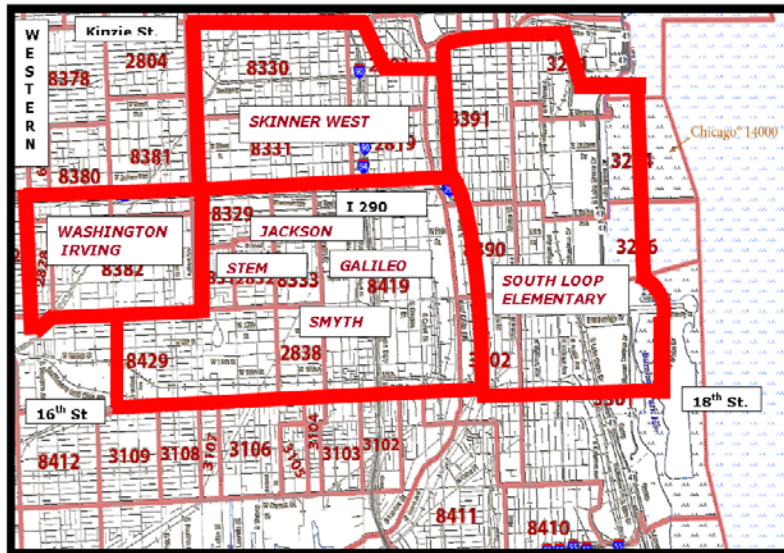

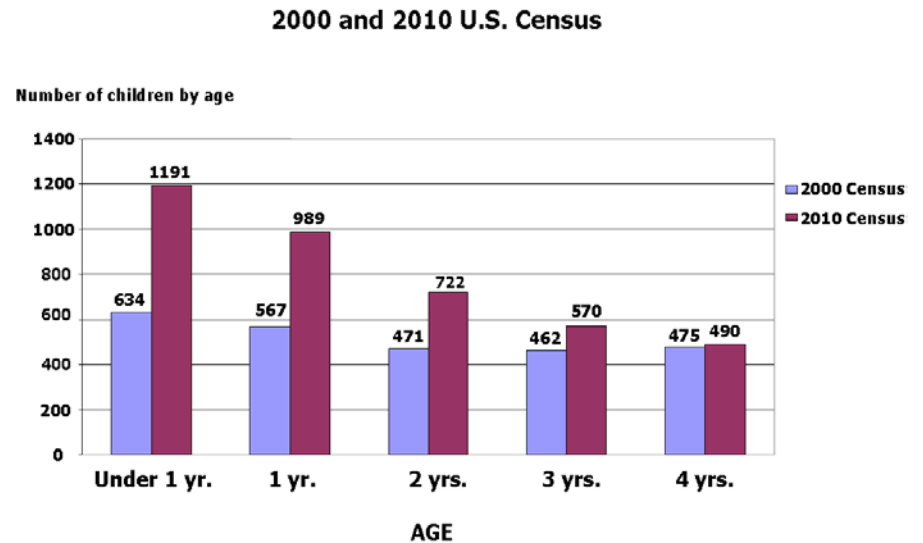
When: *Thursday, May 30th at 6:30 p.m.*

The population in the Central City increased from 38,893 to 81,375 residents (109%) between 1990 and 2010. Yet, people with children left in large numbers. The only age category between the ages of 0 and 17 that did not decline in the Central City was the preschool population, which increased. CPS continues to drive families out of Chicago despite their large take of the total property tax levy.
